Re: ACDBE Certification Reevaluation

Dear Mr. Keys:

In accordance with the U.S. Department of Transportation's Interim Final Rule (IFR), which became effective on October 3, 2025, The Greater Orlando Aviation Authority's Office of Business Opportunity and Exchange (BOeX) has reevaluated Keys Airport Business, Inc. certification and eligibility for continued participation in the Airport Concessions Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (ACDBE) program in Florida, under a Unified Certification Program (UCP) in accordance with 49 CFR, Part 26.

It has been determined that Keys Airport Business, Inc. meets the requirements for continued certification in the ACDBE program. This determination is based on the information provided in your submitted Personal Narrative, business and personal tax returns, and your Personal Net Worth calculations.

The Greater Orlando Aviation Authority (the Authority) is one of nine certifying members of the Florida Unified Certification Program (UCP) that must complete the reevaluation of certified firms in the State of Florida. Each certifying member is responsible for completing the reevaluation of those firms for which it is the Jurisdiction of Original Certification (JOC). The JOC is the entity from which the DBE/ACDBE firm first received DBE/ACDBE certification. The next steps in completing the statewide reevaluation process will be based on a cooperative effort with all the other certifying agencies responsible for implementing the federal DBE and ACDBE programs consistently across the State of Florida.

This coordination is essential to ensure that all certification and compliance procedures remain aligned statewide. Its completion will dictate not only when the Authority will be able to resume counting DBE participation on existing contracts, but when the entire state of Florida will be able to do so.

ACDBE/DBE certification is **NOT** a guarantee of work but enables firms to compete for and perform contract work on all USDOT Federal Aid, FAA, FTA, and FHWA projects in Florida as an ACDBE/DBE contractor, subcontractor, consultant, sub-consultant, or material supplier.

ACDBE/DBE certification continues from your anniversary date listed above, but it is contingent upon your annual renewal of eligibility. Continuing eligibility documentation must be submitted to BOeX, 30 days prior to your anniversary date, via its online certification portal at <https://goaa.gob2g.com/>. You will be notified in advance of your obligation to provide continuing eligibility documentation via automatic system notifications; however, ensuring continued certification is your responsibility. Failure to demonstrate continued eligibility will result in immediate action to decertify Keys Airport Business, Inc. as an ACDBE/DBE.

If, at any time, there is a material change in Keys Airport Business, Inc., including, but not limited to, ownership, officers, directors, scope of work being performed, daily operations, affiliations with other businesses or individuals, or physical location, you must notify BOeX, in writing, within thirty (30) days. Notification should include supporting documentation. You will receive acknowledgment and confirmation of continued eligibility, if applicable, after notification of changes.

Keys Airport Business, Inc. may compete for and perform federal USDOT work based on the following NAICS codes:
